With the last competitors finished by shortly after 2:00, a foursome of skiers... B & E, along with Janet and Jessica, went to pick up the flags. Course designs were by me.

As to awarding laurels...

On the SKI courses... the 13.6 km (2-maps) course was won handily by **Francis Falardeau** in 1:09:00. **David Hunter** and **Michael Bole** finished 2nd and 3rd. **Janet Findlay** was the top woman on the course in 1:29:00. *(Incidentally, Janet won all three of her events at the recent U.S. Ski-Orienteering Championships at the Trapp Family Lodge, Stowe – in her Women's 55+ class. Husband David also won two of his races.)*

On the 8.5 km course, Susie & Glen Wight tied with Dan Kirk for the lead with times of 1:33:00.

In the 6 km Snowshoe event **Philippe Côté-Jacques** and spouse **Caroline Bouchard** edged **Dmitri Golovanov** by two minutes to win : 0:47 / 0:49 mins.
